RESOLUTION NO. 22-__

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS)

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch (the "Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, et seq.) (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Village Mayor (the "Mayor") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board", and together with the Mayor, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to the efficient operation of government; and

WHEREAS, Homeland Security Presidential Directive / HSPD -5 established the National Incident Management System (NIMS); and

WHEREAS, the NIMS established a single, comprehensive approach to domestic incident management to ensure that all levels of government across the Nation have the capability to work efficiently and effectively together using a national approach to domestic incident management; and

WHEREAS, the NIMS provides a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State and local governments to work together to prepare for and respond to, and recover from domestic incidents regardless of cause, size or complexity; and

WHEREAS, the NIMS provides for interoperability and compatibility among Federal, State and local capabilities and includes a core set of concepts, principles, terminology and technologies covering the incident command system, unified command, training, management or resources and reporting; and

WHEREAS, beginning October 1, 2004 all Federal departments and agencies shall make adoption of the NIMS a requirement for providing Federal preparedness assistance through grants, contracts or other activities to local governments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

The Village of Antioch hereby adopts the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as its system of preparing for and responding to disaster incidents
