
The Public Works Department provides snow removal within the Village limits. There are 2 crews plowing & salting 7 routes covering 120 lane miles with 103 cul-de-sacs along with Village owned public parking lots.

## We need your help to keep our roadways safe this winter!

- Be prepared for possible delays; plan your travel time accordingly.
- Parking is not allowed on any street after snow begins to fall and exceed one inch and until snowplowing operations have stopped.
- Give the snow plows room to work; do not follow too closely. If you cannot see their mirror(s) they cannot see you! Plows back up frequently so please maintain a distance of at least 200 feet.
- Typically all main thoroughfares, through streets and cul-de-sacs are salted with the main thoroughfares being cleared first.
- Sidewalks need to be cleared within 24 hours after the cessation of an event of at least two inches of snow.
- Any help to keep fire hydrants clear of snow is appreciated.
- It is unlawful to throw or push snow from your driveway into or across the street. See diagram below to help reduce the amount.



## **MAILBOXES**

Any mailbox taking a direct hit from the snow plow will be reimbursed up to seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars if it cannot be reasonably replaced or repaired by the Public Works Department. Any damage resulting from the force of the snow will not be reimbursed.
